### Primary Responsibilities/Essential Job Functions

- Effectively teaches knowledge, skills, and Christian values related to course objectives in the classroom and laboratory.
- Capable and willing to teach a spectrum of biology courses from ecology through various organismal courses, anatomy and physiology, cell biology, and research methods.
- Actively participating in serving as an advisor for students' scholarly capstone projects.
- Candidates with past research experience and a desire to lead undergraduate research are highly sought.

### Minimum Education & Experience Requirements:

- Required – Master's degree and training, experience, and comfort in some aspect or aspects of organismal biology.
- Highly preferred – Doctorate with a minimum of 30 graduate quarter hours or 18 graduate semester hours earned in biology.
